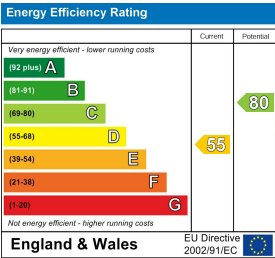
Floor Plan
