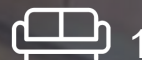

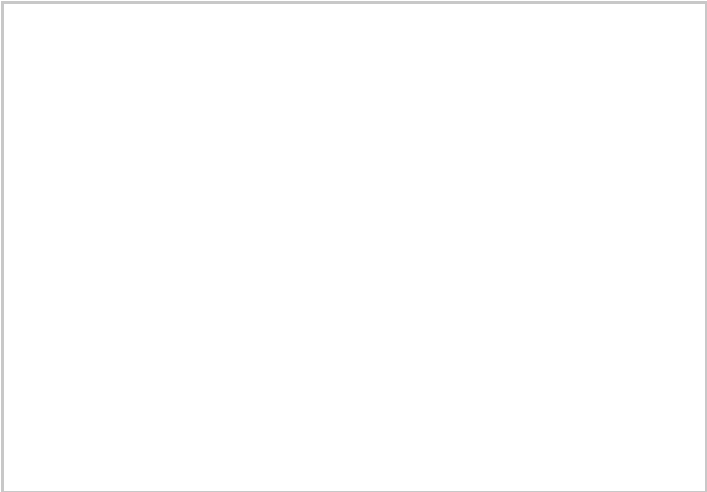
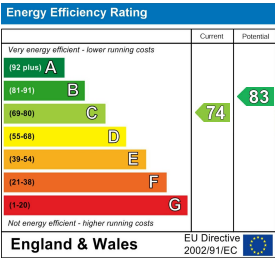
Floor Plan
