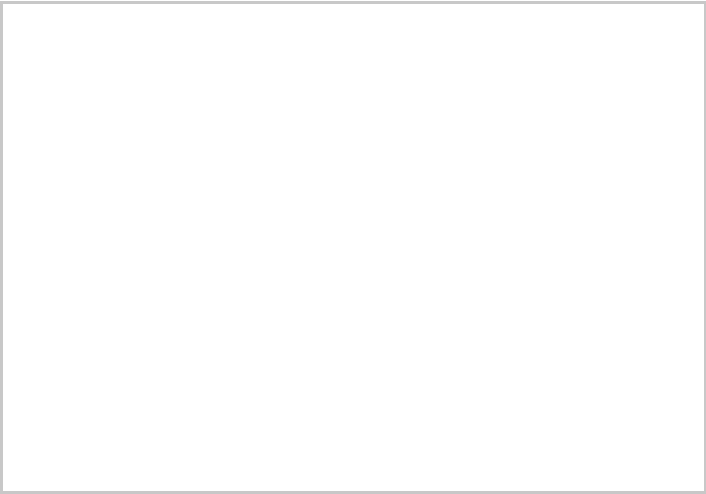
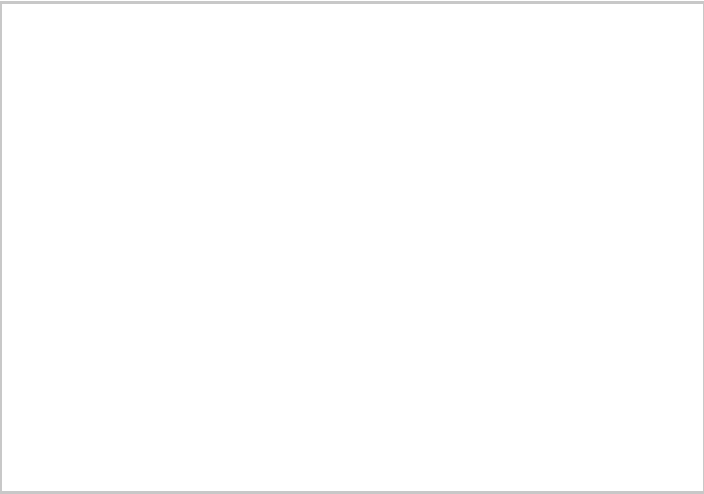
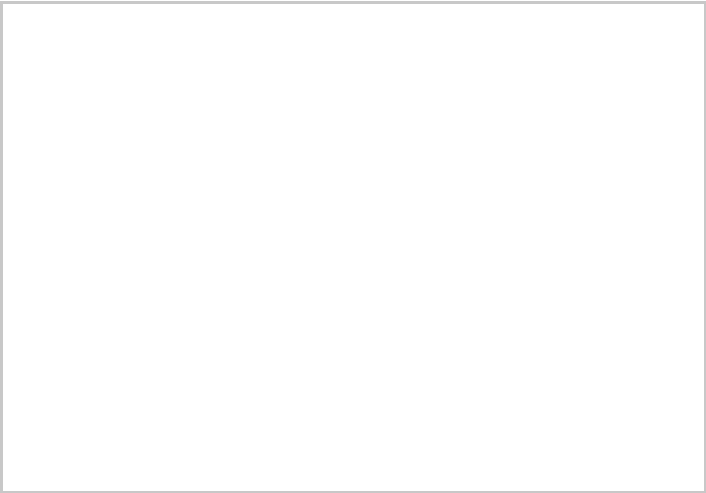
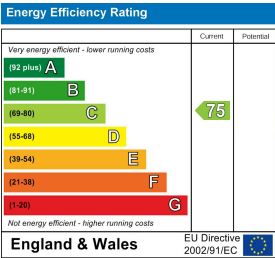
Floor Plan
